Tip of the head, part of the body, doesn't matter. The fact is that you're more accurate in first person because the camera angle screws with targeting. I usually play in third. I only switch to first so I can hit people that are being obscured by geometry or some kind of object.

You're more accurate, but you will hit less. Try hitting the tip of the head unscoped...it's practically impossible in 1st person as well. In every other situation 3rd person will lock on the enemy soldier even if you're not directly aiming at him, which is a major advantage.
