I agree, but on servers like n00bstories, there is no !bl feature. A lot of the time (Especially in APCs or Humvees), I don't have an Engineer or Hotwire. Usually I lug around a Gunner or PIC Sydney or something in those cases. If the barracks is down, I'm not about to give up a PIC Sydney when there are three Hotwires sitting around me with nothing to do.

Renegade is still a team-based game. A little helping out your teammates won't hurt. I always stop and repair any wayward vechs when I can. Is it so wrong to expect the same in return?

Edit..these are just IMO.

To elaborate on the final point, I am aware of the effectiveness of snipers against things like recon bikes and Orcas/Apaches. These are quite effective countermeasures against quick manoeuvre/light armor vehicles. However they are completely USELESS against a flame rush. Somehow I don't think getting 50 points per shot is going to save your infantry barracks.
