cheat name removed does not alter the physical game.exe on disk, it hacks in memory. The auto-update that happens (what I see happening to him), is when the actual game.exe on disk is changed. RenGuard detects this and forces itself to auto-update (download a correct copy).

So, he is either editing the EXE himself, or he has a virus that is doing it. Most viruses automatically add themselves to the blank space at the end of any .exe and .com files it finds on the disk.
