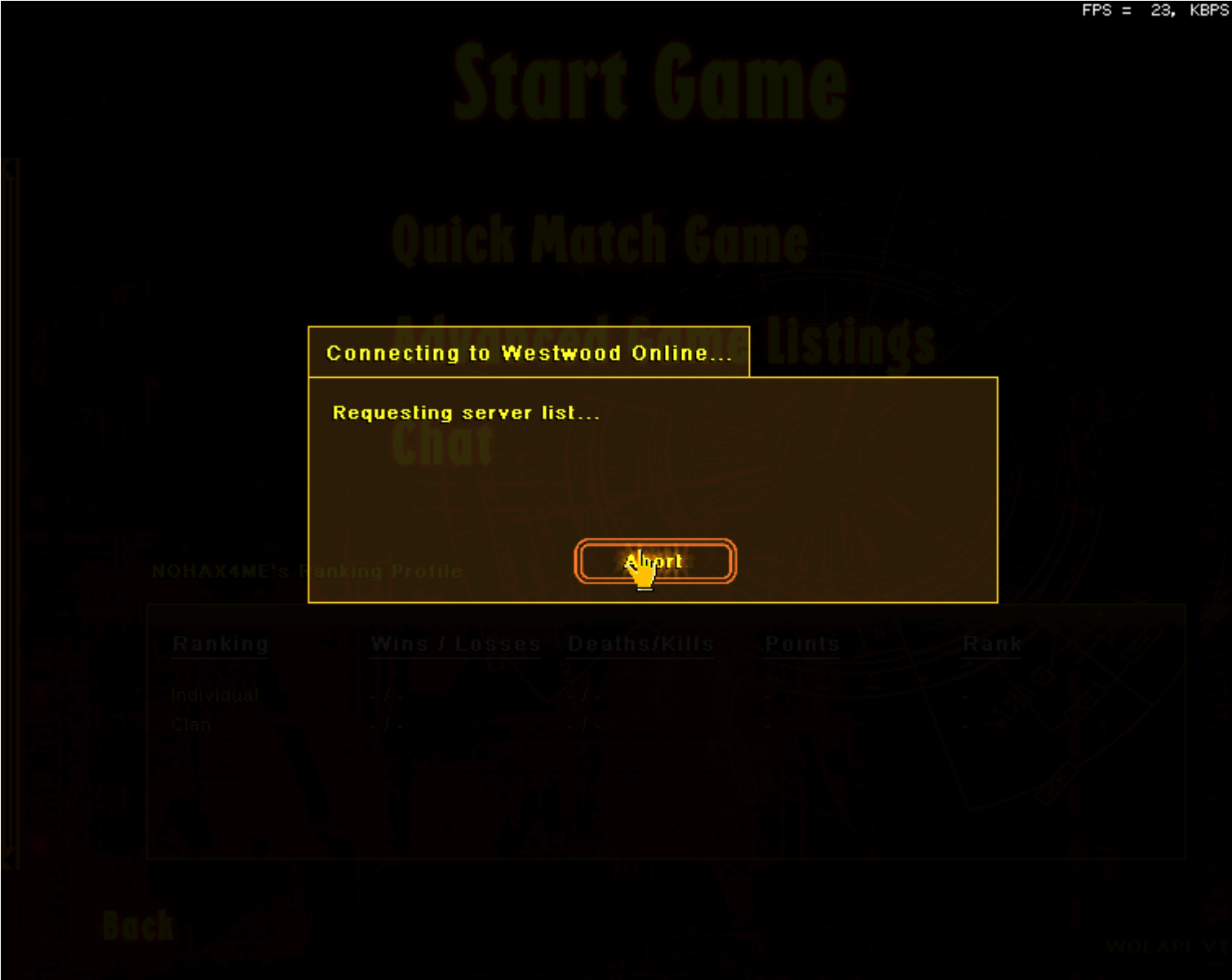

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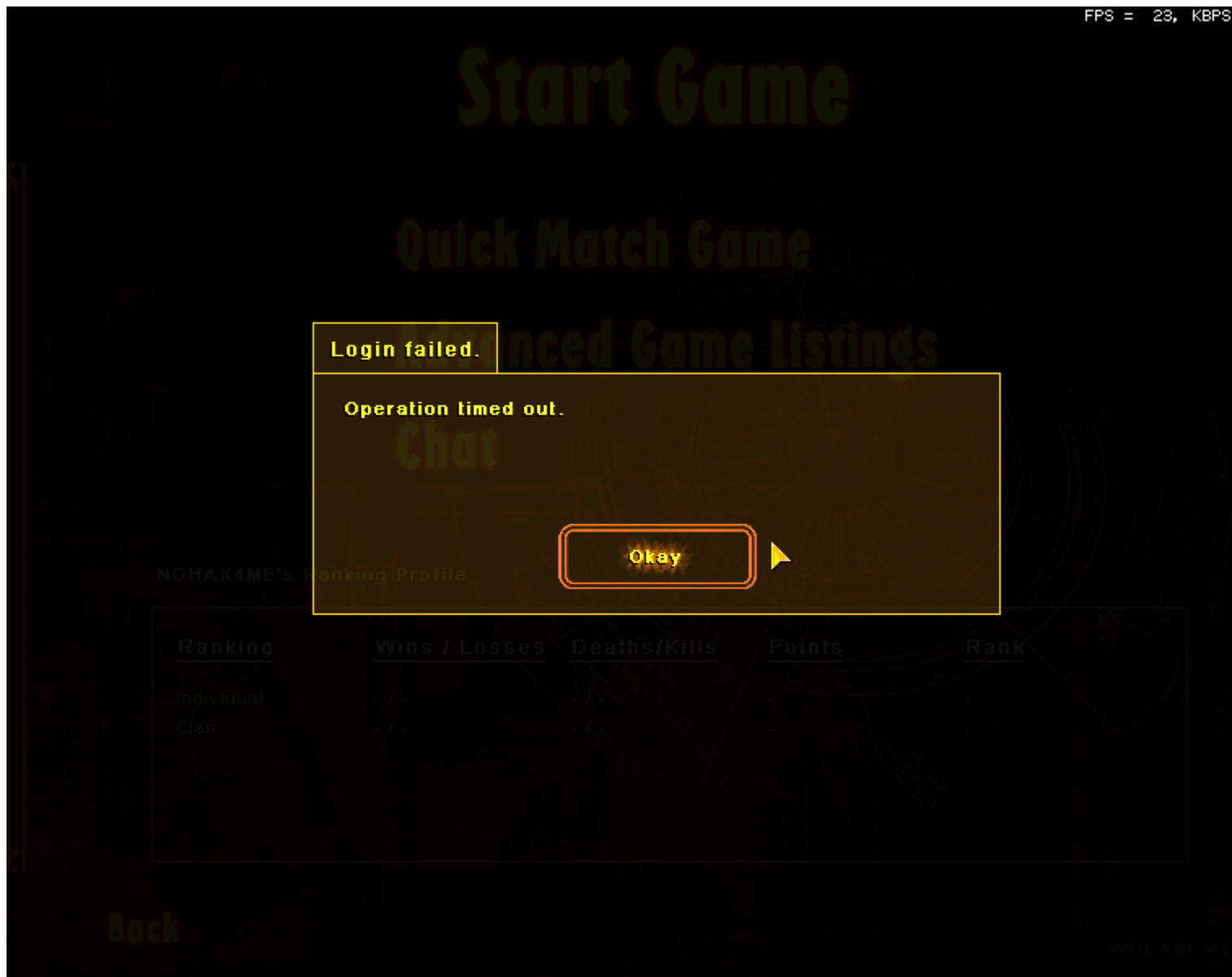
I reinstalled ren, patched, got RG, uninstalled and reinstalled Westwood shared, deleted skins.....

195.13.63.187 irc.westwood.com

195.13.63.187 servserv.westwood.com

Then try to connect again. If it doesn't work, then restore the file to its original content.
