What CPU do you have Blue_Leader? Renegade online is rather CPU intensive. That video card should be able to play Renegade, but not with high resolution/AA and all that. My old GeForce4 Ti4200 (much better than an FX 5200) managed 1280x960 resolution with 4xAF and 2xAA as a maximum (remember AA and AF penalized the GeForce4 series hard) without losing too much FPS.

CRTs refresh rates are generally higher thus allowing more FPS. But its not going to help if your card can't proform to the standard of 60FPS.
