I go back and look and I screwed everything up! Anyway to turn it back on?

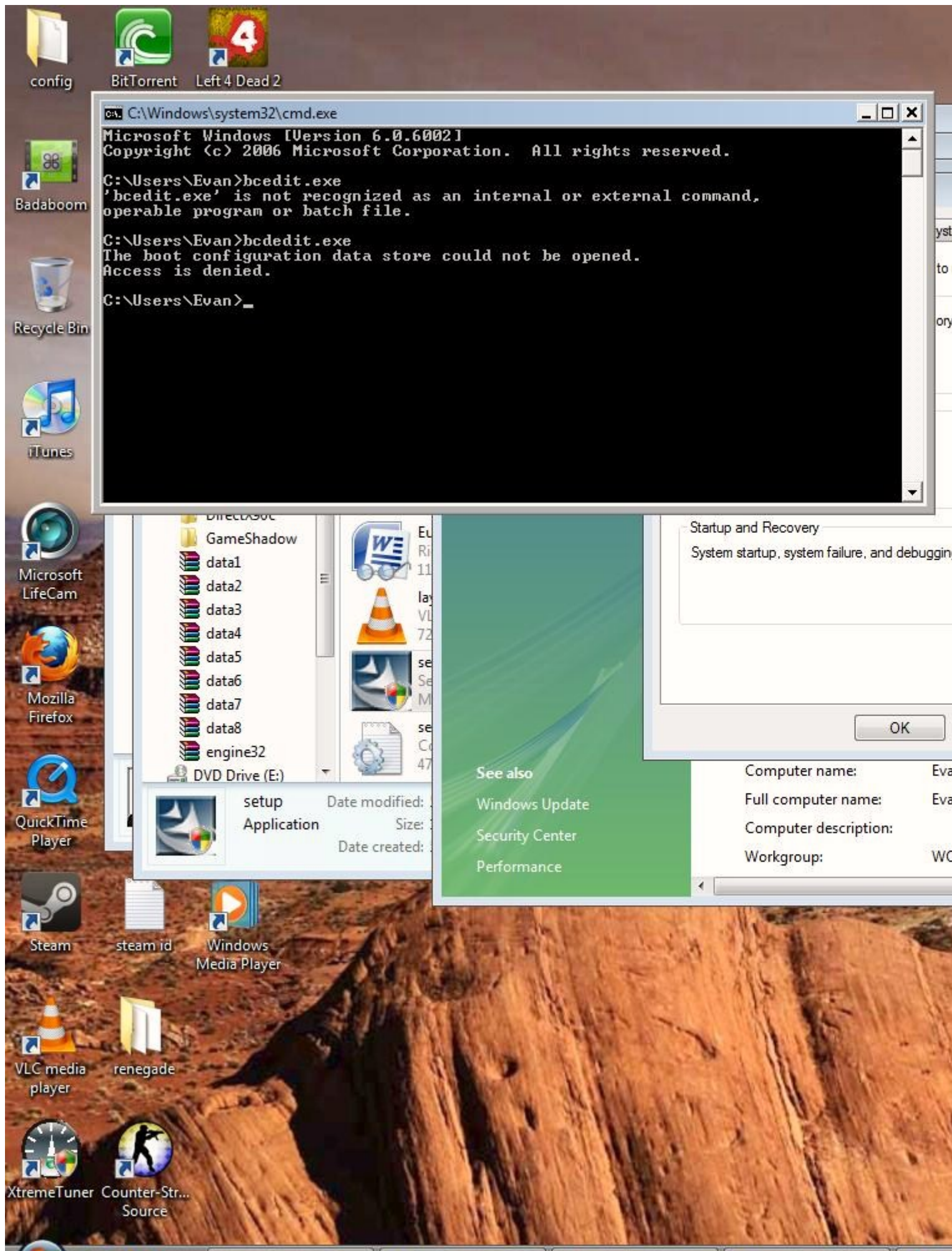
Here is a picture.
