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Yes, you can still play Renegade online.

Even though you already installed patch 1.037, you still have to install Core-Patch 2 and the newest scripts.

Steps to get it working:

- 1.Download <http://download.renguard.com/cp2/patcher.zip>
- 2.Download <http://download.renguard.com/cp2/patchall.zip>
- 3.Unzip both zip files into your renegade folder and overwrite any files if asked.
- 4.Double click on patcher.exe which will run the patching process.

You have now installed Core-Patch 2. Then you must install Scripts 3.4.4, you can get them here:

I suggest you then install Renegade Ressurrection. This has a built-in serverlist, which allows you to join any server listed there, without having to launch Renegade first. You can get it here:
