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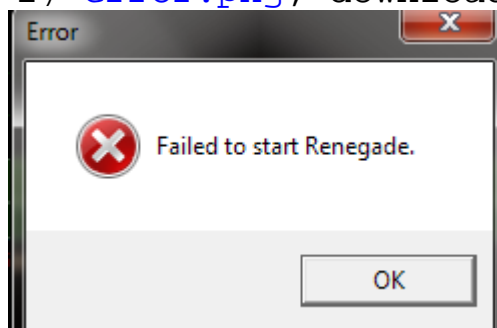

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Did you let mixcheck finish, or did you abort it? It should run until it says it's finished, and can take a while. It downloads the missing or corrupt files and will put them where they should be. If it completed but you still do not have an always.dat in your ...\\Renegade\\data folder, then something is blocking mixcheck.exe from writing to that folder, most likely Norton or some other anti virus program.

If nothing works, uninstall Renegade, remove the Renegade folder entirely, and reinstall Renegade and then TT. If that doesn't work either, contact me on MSN or similar and I'll help you via TeamViewer.
